At **Suzy's Hidey Hall** a worm with a flat head helps break down the old. Count the pointed tips on the star that it holds!



This **Main Bug Hotel** is a towering flat, home to a bug that's often quite fat. How many wings does a true fly possess? Find this number for your next success.

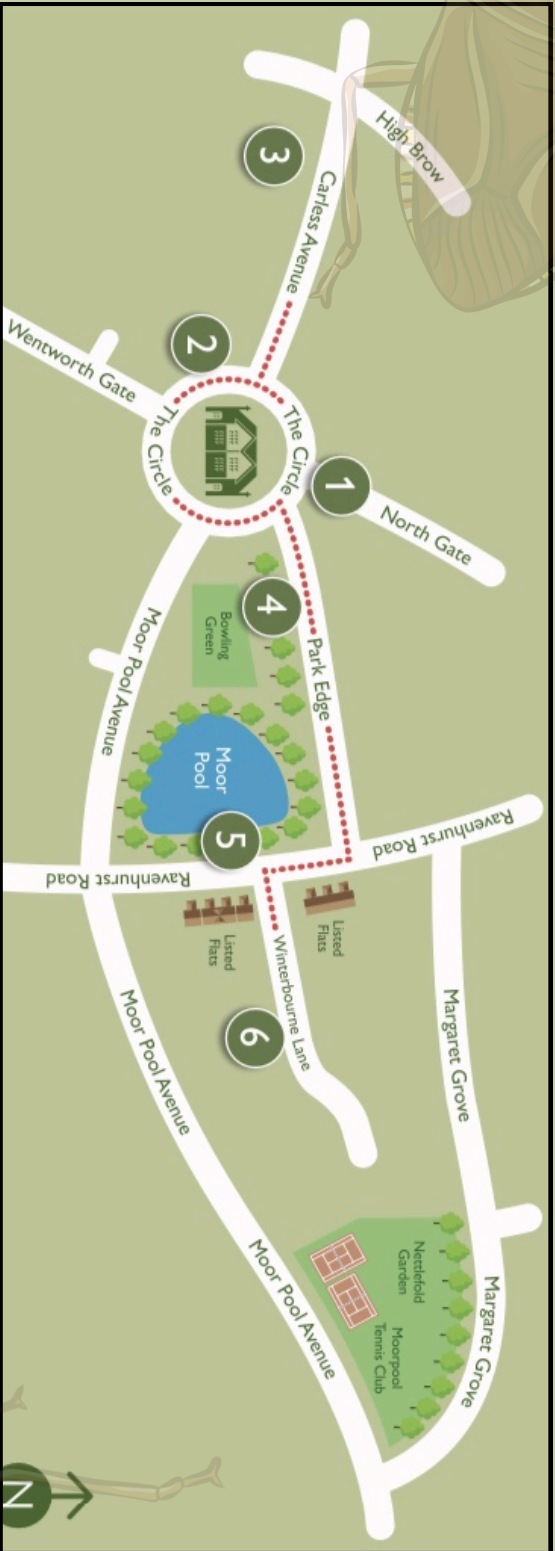

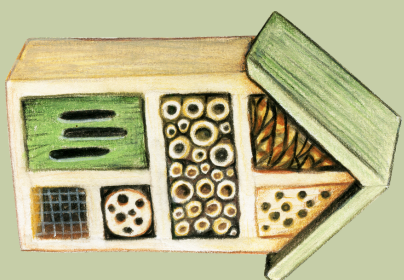
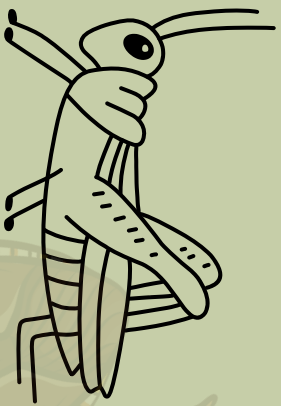
